Waiver_Purpose: My work is part of an official Illinois Dept. of Transportation planning study intending to help protect the health and safety of construction contractors, the general public, and the environment. The project

for which I am completing a hazardous materials assessment is located in the Lake Bluff area at US 41 and IL 176 (interchange project). The site in question is at the southeast corner of this interchange.

Waiver_ExtentToExtractAnalyze: I am conducting a full regulatory document review of all properties on or adjacent to this project for the Illinois Department of Transportation (IDOT). A Preliminary Environmental Site Assessment (PESA) report will be submitted to IDOT based upon this review and subsequent investigations.

Waiver_SpecificActivityQuals: I am the senior environmental professional in my field office working on contract to the IDOT and am based in the Greater Chicago metropolitan area. The information will be part of an assessment of risk associated with a state infrastructure development project. My report will be the property of the Illinois Department of Transportation.

Waiver_ImpactPublicUnderstanding: Information reviewed from state and federal environmental protection agencies indicated potential NRC involvement at this site. Online searches turned up a previous FOIA for this site within your agency (FOIA/PA-97-388) perhaps indicating the presence of NRC records pertaining to this site. Due diligence requires that I review any releasable information you may have.

Waiver_NatureOfPublic: This is a state infrastructure development project involving two highways (US 41 and IL 176) and the general public.

This planning information will be used in possible engineering and construction efforts for this interchange redesign project.
