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LICENSEE:

The inspection was an examination of the activities conducted under your license as they relate to radiation safety and to compliance with the Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC) rules and regulations and the conditions of your license. The inspection consisted of selective examinations of procedures and representative records, interviews with personnel, and observations by the inspector. The inspection findings are as follows:

- 1. Based on the inspection findings, no violations were identified.
- 2. Previous violation(s) closed.
- 3. The violation(s), specifically described to you by the inspector as non-cited violations, are not being cited because they were self-identified, non-repetitive, and corrective action was or is being taken, and the remaining criteria in the NRC Enforcement Policy to exercise discretion, were satisfied.



10 CFR 34.49 requires all areas in which industrial radiography is being performed be conspicuously posted as required by §20.1902(a), which requires that the licensee post each radiation area with a sign or signs bearing the radiation symbol and the words "CAUTION, RADIATION AREA."

Contrary to the above, the licensee failed to conspicuously post a sign or signs bearing the radiation symbol and the words "CAUTION, RADIATION AREA" while conducting industrial radiography. Specifically, on August 02, 2011, at a temporary jobs site at the facilities of ASRC in Anchorage, Alaska, an area with a radiation dose rate of approximately 5 milliRem/hour within close proximity to the crank on the end of the crank-out cable did not have a sign or signs posted designating the radiation area.

The licensee committed to provide remedial training to radiographers and radiographer assistants on required posting at temporary jobs sites. The training was to be completed within thirty (30) days of the day this inspection report was signed.

Licensee's Statement of Corrective Actions for Item 4, above.

I hereby state that, within 30 days, the actions described by me to the inspector will be taken to correct the violations identified. This statement of corrective actions is made in accordance with the requirements of 10 CFR 2.201 (corrective steps already taken, corrective steps which will be taken, date when full compliance will be achieved). I understand that no further written response to NRC will be required, unless specifically requested.
