The License Renewal Application (LRA), Appendix E, "Applicant's Environmental Report – Operating License Renewal Stage," Attachment D, "Coastal Zone Management Consistency," provided certification documenting the FENOC determination that U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC) renewal of the Davis-Besse operating license would be consistent with enforceable policies of the approved Ohio Coastal Management Program.



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
