ORDER

(Granting Motion to Modify Deadline for Initial Disclosures)

The NRC Staff having extended its safety review schedule by eleven months, NextEra Energy Seabrook, LLC moves to modify the deadline for initial disclosures.¹

No party having objected, and for good cause shown, the motion is granted. Paragraph II(A)(1) of the Initial Scheduling Order² is amended to replace “October 3, 2011” with “April 2, 2012.” Thus, mandatory disclosures and the Staff’s hearing file shall be produced within thirty (30) days of the Commission’s disposition of pending appeals of the Board’s February 15, 2011
