In our response (Ref. 1) to Inspection Report 80-21, Significant Finding 4, we stated that we expected to have a formal ALARA program document completed by November 1, 1981. Due to unanticipated difficulty in selecting a qualified consultant to assist with this project, we now find that the program will not be completed by this date. A consultant has now been selected, however, and work on a formal ALARA program document is in progress. We currently anticipate the program document and a schedule for implementation will be completed by February 15, 1982.
