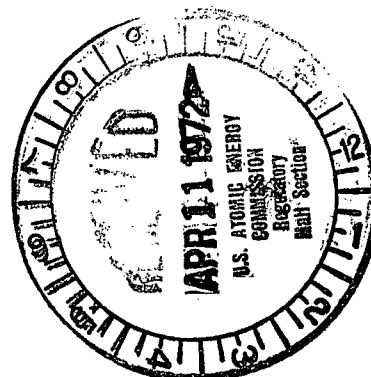

We have received your letter of March 13, 1972, concerning the dynamic effects of blow-down through the relief valve discharge line into the suppression pool.

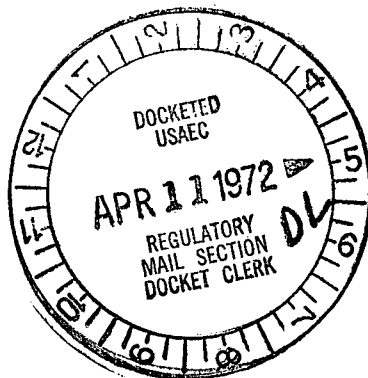
