Dear Mr. Lear:

Your letter of December 20, 1977 concerning the NRC fire protection review team visit November 28 - December 2, 1977 forwarded enclosures with staff positions and comments, a request for additional information and commitments made resulting from that visit. Your letter requested that we respond to all questions and attend a one-day meeting to discuss the final resolution of staff concerns and positions.

We believe that during the week of January 9, 1978 we can discuss with you by telephone our responses to your letter of December 20, 1977, and that a meeting the following week would be acceptable. However, a one-week delay for the telephone response and meeting would result in more complete answers and resolutions based on firmer foundations. We would document our responses in writing after the meeting.
