The license requested to add Ra 226 (Seaman gauges) to its license but did not specify how many of these gauges they are acquiring (The letter requests to add a Seaman gauge, but also states Model C-200 and C-300). I called the licensee to clear the ambiguity. The licensee stated that they had one Model C-200 which they want to include in their license and they have 7 CPN gauges that are already on the license.

I reviewed the license and determined that the license authorized only six CPN gauges. The licensee stated that they acquired the seventh CPN gauge few years back and now they have a total of 8 gauges in their possession.

It appears that they licensee may be in violation of NRC requirements. The licensee had difficulty communicating in English. An inspection is needed to determine how the licensee acquired material in excess of authorized limits and what caused the delay in including the Seaman gauge to its license.
