The license does not specify maximum possession limit in Item 8. On July 12, 2011 at around 12:30 p.m., I called the licensee to explain current NRC policy and request the total number of gauges in their current inventory.

The licensee stated that they have 9 portable gauges. I explained to him that they do not need to include all of these gauges on their NRC license because they do not have any storage location in NRC jurisdiction.

The licensee stated that they do not expect to have more than one or two gauges at one time in any areas of NRC jurisdiction and suggested that authorization for 4 gauges will be more than sufficient for their needs. He stated that they would like to have authorization for 2 Model 3440 and 2 Model 3411 Troxler gauges.

I informed him that their license will be administratively amended to include their request. On August 25, 2011, I requested LAT to open a licensing action to administratively amend the license.
