SUBJECT: YOUR LETTERS DATED AUGUST 12, 2011

Dear CDR Davis-Urgo:

This letter refers to your two letters dated August 12, 2011, responding to the Notices of Violation (NOV) enclosed with our letters dated July 15 and 18, 2011.

The NOV enclosed with our July 15, 2011 letter cited two violations, which had been identified by the NRC during an inspection at the Space and Naval Warfare Systems Center (SPAWAR) in San Diego, California (Inspection Report No. 03029462/2011005). The NOV enclosed with our July 18, 2011 letter cited twelve violations which were identified during the NRC's biennial review of the Navy's Master Materials License (MML) (Inspection Report No. 03029462/2011006). All violations were classified at Severity Level IV.

Thank you for describing your corrective and preventive actions with regard to Violation A as described in the NOV enclosed with our letter dated July 15, 2011, and Violations A through K as described in the NOV enclosed with our letter dated July 18, 2011. These actions will be reviewed during a future inspection of your licensed program.

With regard to Violation B as described in the NOV enclosed with our letter dated July 15, 2011, and Violation L as described in the NOV enclosed with our letter dated July 18, 2011, you disputed the violations and described the basis for your dispute. The NRC is in the process of reviewing the basis for your dispute and will notify you of the results of this review in writing.
