


Clarification To Item #3 on "Application For Materials License" (NRC Form 313)

Licensed material will be stored at the Materials Testing Laboratory, 11283 Schaefer Drive, Maryland Heights, Missouri 63043, and will be used at temporary job sites of the licensee (Saint Louis County, Missouri) anywhere in the United States where the U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission maintains jurisdiction for regulating the use of licensed material. (Note that temporary job sites are located almost exclusively in Saint Louis County, Missouri.)

Licensed material will only be used by, or under the supervision and in the physical presence of, individuals who have satisfactorily completed the device manufacturer's training program for gauge users and have been designated by the licensee's (Saint Louis County) Radiation Safety Officer. The licensee will maintain records of the individuals who have been designated as authorized users.

At the time of the above application, the Radiation Safety Officer for the activities authorized by this license is Joseph John Brouk Jr.
