The walkover and consultation for the proposed Ross uranium ISR project in Oshoto, WY, will take place on September 13 and 14. Eleven tribes indicated that they can attend. For those tribes that cannot make those dates, a second site walkover and consultation meeting will be conducted/scheduled in October (dates not established, yet).

Next week an agenda for both the site walkover and consultation will be sent.
