SOURCE MATERIAL LICENSE

Pursuant to the Atomic Energy Act of 1954, and Title 10, Code of Federal Regulations, Chapter 1, Part 40, "Licensing of Source Material," and in reliance on statements and representations heretofore made by the licensee, a license is hereby issued authorizing the licensee to receive, possess and import the source material designated below; to use such material for the purpose(s) and at the place(s) designated below; and to deliver or transfer such material to persons authorized to receive it in accordance with the regulations in said Part. This license shall be deemed to contain the conditions specified in Section 193 of the Atomic Energy Act of 1954 and is subject to all applicable rules, regulations, and orders of the Atomic Energy Commission, now or hereafter in effect, including Title 10, Code of Federal Regulations, Chapter 1, Part 20, "Standards for Protection Against Radiation," and to any conditions specified below.

CONDITIONS

8. Authorized use (Unless otherwise specified, the authorized place of use is the licensee's address stated in Item 2 above.)

For fabrication of uranium component parts for small arms and artillery ammunition at United States Army Munitions Command Complex (Lake City Ordnance Plant, Frankford Arsenal and Picatinny Arsenal locations) and for the testing of ammunition in accordance with the procedures and conditions described in the applications for license submitted by the Ordnance Corps dated May 1, June 2 and September 26, 1961; and the licensee's letters dated September 20, 1962; and August 13, 1963. The licensee is further authorized to distribute small arms and artillery rounds to field units of the Army and to use such rounds for military purposes in accordance with the procedures described in the licensee's application dated September 19, 1961. This license authorizes the export of small arm and artillery ammunition containing uranium components for military purposes.
