9/08/11 14:15 I left a message on Mr. Jacobs voice-mail to get back in touch with me. 14:45 Mr. Jacobs called back while I was occupied on the phone and left a message. 14:55 I spoke with Mr. Jacobs. When I informed Mr. Jacobs of the unpaid invoice, he stated that he was unaware of it. He did mention paying a \$100 registration fee. I gave him the name and number of Shirley Crutchfield to contact and straighten out the matter regarding the fees for the specific license. I also asked Mr. Jacobs to confirm that the gauge in the company's possession had a plaque indicating it was possessed under a general license. He was able to look at the one at his location but would need time to check the other device. I informed him if both gauges were so labeled, then he could request termination of the specific license. However, such action would need to be started prior to September 30th to avoid another invoice for Fiscal Year 2012.

9/9/11 Elizabeth Ullrich requested that I contact the licensee and determine if the licensee will be terminating its license. Thomas Thompson is scheduled to perform an inspection at the licensee's location and would need that information. 15:50 I left a message for Mr. Jacobs to contact me.

9/12/11 I spoke with Mr. Jacobs. Mr. Jacobs had spoken with Shirley Crutchfield and a new invoice would be drafted. The Order Revoking License for Nonpayment of Fees would not be issued. I asked Mr. Jacobs for the serial numbers on the two XRFs. He stated that they were 7228 and 7233. I found them in GLTS under Metal Management – Northeast, recipient code 711437. Metal Management is the parent company, Metal Management - Northeast is a regional branch, and the licensee is a local subdivision. I also saw three other XRFs listed which Mr. Jacobs stated they no longer possessed. I requested that Mr. Jacobs contact the manufacturer so that GLTS could be corrected as to which XRFs were possessed and the name of the recipient. I informed Mr. Jacobs that if he gets a request in writing in to the regional office to terminate the license prior to 9/30/11, then no additional fees would be assessed to his program.
