SUBJECT: NAVY RADIATION SAFETY COMMITTEE STANDARD OPERATING  
PROCEDURES MANUAL

The Naval Radiation Safety Committee (NRSC) requested amendment 15 to the Navy's Master Materials License (MML), No. 45-23645-01NA, in our letter 5104 Ser N455C/N5U9011436 of 30 January 2006. In this request we forwarded our Standard Operating Procedures (SOP), revision number three to ensure compliance with applicable NRC regulations. Subsequently the amended license was forwarded to the NRSC in your letter of 3 May 2006.

The NRSC is now requesting that our SOP be untied from condition 18 of the MML. We are requesting this amendment because we believe that it will expedite any changes and updates to the SOP, which ultimately would be delayed due to the process of amending the MML. The untying of the SOP is also in agreement with section 3.10.11 of NUREG 1556, Volume 10, Consolidated Guidance About Materials Licenses, wherein it states that internal procedures do not have to be submitted with an application. Although this amendment request is in agreement with current NRC guidance, we want to assure you that the NRSC intends to maintain its SOP current and in agreement with NRC regulations.
