SUBJECT: FERMI 3, COMBINED LICENSE APPLICATION – ADVANCED FINAL
SAFETY EVALUATION FOR CHAPTER 17, “QUALITY ASSURANCE”

By letter dated September 18, 2008, Detroit Edison Company (Detroit Edison) submitted an application to the U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC) for a combined license (COL) for Fermi 3.

Based on our review of the application, the staff is providing the Advisory Committee on Reactor Safeguards (ACRS) its Advanced Final Safety Evaluation (AFSE) for Chapter 17, “Quality Assurance” (ML112630120). Unless otherwise stated in the AFSE, the staff’s review was based on Revision 3 of the application. The AFSE is being provided to support a meeting of the subcommittee of the ACRS scheduled for October 21, 2011. The ACRS full committee meeting will be held after the subcommittee meeting.

In accordance with the memorandum to the ACRS dated March 17, 2010 (ML100700612), the staff has reviewed the submitted information against the categories for which the ACRS requested be used to highlight information for review by the committee. The staff’s assessment of this chapter is that there are no items that meet the categories for discussion with the committee.
