Provided below are responses to your two inquiries. I would like to briefly discuss status with you later this afternoon. Are you available around 1;30 today?

1. Please provide the chain of ownership/relationship of the entities that make up UniStar and the parent company/companies. Please indicate the construction chain and the operation chain up to the parent companies.

ANSWER: The applicant, Calvert Cliffs 3 Nuclear Project, LLC, a Delaware limited liability company, is indirectly wholly-owned via two holding companies (UniStar Project

Holdings, LLC and UniStar Nuclear Holdings, LLC) by UniStar Nuclear Energy, LLC ("UNE"). UNE is a wholly-owned indirect subsidiary of E.D.F. International S.A.S.

("EDFI"). EDFI is in turn a wholly owned subsidiary of the largest nuclear power operator in the world, Electricité de France S.A..

2. Please provide draft conservation easement documents for the mitigation areas. Also, please provide a draft document to provide us assurance that the tidal mitigation area would be protected/monitored/remediated and how this would be accomplished since the tidal mitigation area would be in State waters. Do you have any agreement with the State? We will coordinate these documents with our Office of Counsel and have these finalized with the final permit decision. Please see the Restrictive Covenant/Financial Assurance/Bond Surety links and use them to create the drafts for our review.

ANSWER: Two draft "Declaration of Restrictive Covenants" for non-tidal mitigation are attached. One to be executed by CALVERT CLIFFS 3 NUCLEAR POWER PROJECT, LLC for non-tidal mitigation on their

respective property and one to be executed by CALVERT CLIFFS NUCLEAR POWER PLANT, LLC (existing Units 1&2) for non-tidal mitigation on their respective property.

Tidal mitigation in the form of at least 4.5 acres of restoration or enhancement of benthic habitat to improve foraging habitat for fish species, as suggested by and being coordinated with the Maryland Department of the Environment (MDE)/National Marine Fisheries Service (NMFS), is still in the initial phase of planning. A plan for identifying the appropriate location has been developed and accepted by the agencies. A site selection evaluation is in process which will identify a recommended tidal mitigation project location. Once concurrence is provided by the agencies then the next step will be the development of an implementation plan and project design. The milestone for completion of these latter steps is far out in the future and will address how the tidal mitigation area would be protected/monitored/remediated. As such, UniStar cannot provide specifics at this early stage of the project but can assure that all applicable regulations and bonding requirements will be in place prior to starting any tidal mitigation work.
