The purpose of this letter is to inform the NRC of a change being made to the Online Reference Portal (ORP) maintained by Florida Power & Light Company (FPL) as described in the referenced letter. This change is necessary to mitigate ORP space constraints experienced when document additions result in the contracted hosting threshold being exceeded.

With this change FPL will be selecting documents for removal from the ORP based on two criteria: the length of time that the document has been in the ORP ('first in – first out') and/or frequency of inspection by NRC reviewers. The oldest and least accessed documents will be reviewed and removed from the ORP to maintain the ORP within the contracted hosting threshold. An index of the removed documents will be easily identifiable to the NRC reviewers when accessing the ORP. This index will assist the NRC reviewers in identifying documents that may need to be reinstated to the ORP for inspection, if required for further NRC inspection. FPL will promptly return any removed document at the NRC's request.

This change is effective October 3, 2011 and will be maintained throughout the duration of the Turkey Point Unit 6 & 7 COL Application review process.
