2) Physical Description

This shipment consists of 5 x 20' containers loaded with 3830 x Gd UO₂ rods packed into 26 x Traveller packages, USA/9297/AF-96 Rev 3. RADIOACTIVE MATERIAL, Type A Package, Fissile. Total net weight of U is 7,306 kgs. The net weight of U-235 is 338 kgs.

3) Transportation and Route Schedule

The ocean transportation from Gothenburg, Sweden to the Port of Norfolk, VA will be the responsibility of Atlantic Container Line. The inland transportation from Norfolk, VA to Columbia, SC will be the responsibility of Westinghouse Electric Corporation.


