Enclosed is Amendment No. 3 amending your NRC Material License No. 12-32746-01 in accordance with your request. Please note that the changes made to your license are printed in **bold font**.

Please review the enclosed document carefully and be sure that you understand all conditions. If there are any errors or questions, please notify the U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission, Region III office at (630) 829-9887 so that we can provide appropriate corrections and answers.

This also refers to your letters dated February 10, 2011, and September 8 and 12, 2001, notifying the NRC of the transfer of ownership and control of License 12-32746-01 issued to GEOCON Engineering, Inc.

The transferee should note their new responsibility and liability as an NRC licensee. Specifically, responsibility is emphasized with regard to any ongoing NRC inspection and enforcement issues, investigations, facility decontamination and decommissioning funding resources. Please be advised, change of ownership/control cannot be transferred without **prior** written consent from the NRC (10 CFR 30.34 (b)). 
In addition, as we discussed by telephone on September 13, 2011, we have added a license condition (20) regarding occupational dosimetry.

Since serious consequences to employees and the public can result from failure to comply with NRC requirements, prompt and vigorous enforcement action will be taken when dealing with licensees who do not achieve the necessary meticulous attention to detail and the high standard of compliance which the NRC expects of its licensees.
