

Transfer of Materials Licence

On behalf Surtron Technologies US, Inc., a Delaware corporation ("Surtron US"), I write with regard to the letter dated August 3, 2011 requesting the transfer of Materials Licence No. 35-04017-04 from Century Geophysical Corporation ("CGC") to Surtron US. As Jonathan Graber explained in the August 3 letter, Surtron US is pursuing the purchase certain assets from CGC, including all needed to conduct the Wireline Logging business in which the devices requiring the Materials Licence are utilised (the "Transaction").

However, in the interim between the August 3 letter and now, the proposed transaction of assets covered by the Materials Licence has been indefinitely put on hold. As a result, Surtron US respectfully requests that the Materials Licence transfer review process be suspended without termination until we can determine when or if the proposed transaction will be finalised. If you are not able to accommodate such a suspension of the transfer process, please terminate the transfer application.
