LICENSEE:

The inspection was an examination of the activities conducted under your license as they relate to radiation safety and to compliance with the Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC) rules and regulations and the conditions of your license. The inspection consisted of selective examinations of procedures and representative records, interviews with personnel, and observations by the inspector. The inspection findings are as follows:



Contrary to the above, on September 12, 2011, a gauge user transported a gauge containing licensed material to the licensee's temporary job site and the licensee did not provide to the user, a copy of its operating and emergency procedures described in Appendix H to NUREG 1556, Vol 1, Rev. 1.

As corrective action the licensee committed to provide copies of these procedures to each authorized user and include the procedures in the shipping papers that the users carry to temporary job sites.

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Statement of Corrective Actions
