Summary of discussion: Chris Allen confirmed that all fire departments (municipal, and independent - volunteer) in Lea County and all police/sheriff departments in Lee County (municipal and county) have mutual aid agreements. Mr. Allen also confirmed that the area near the intersection of highways 483,529,180/62 is called Arkansas Junction. Arkansas Junction is served by the Monument Volunteer Fire Department, but the Hobbs Fire Department serves as a back-up. Arkansas Junction is the site of the proposed project.
