This is in reference to your letter dated September 7, 2011, requesting to amend Nuclear Regulatory Commission License No. 45-23645-01. In order to continue our review, we need the following additional information:

In support of your request to remove your standard operating procedures from the tie down conditions listed in Condition 18 of the above mentioned license, please confirm that you will have and will maintain written internal procedures that address, at a minimum, the functions specified in Section 3.10.11 of NUREG-1556, Vol 10, "Consolidated Guidance About Materials Licenses, Program-Specific Guidance About Master Materials Licenses." Also, please confirm that you will adhere to NRC guidance, policy, and procedures, in order to implement your oversight of the Navy's use of radioactive materials in a manner parallel to that of the NRC.
