Jim:

Here are the answers to your questions:

- For ten years of Class A, B, and C resin shipments received at Barnwell, there were approximately 78.5% Type A casks and 21.5% Type B casks. Almost all the resin shipments arrived inside a cask.
- Approximately 80 – 90% of Class A resin shipments are shipped in Type A casks.
- Each cask holds one resin liner and the two most popular sizes for Class A resins are the 14-215 cask (205.8 cu.ft. disposal volume) and the 8-120A cask (120.3 cu.ft. disposal volume).
- Only one Type A cask is shipped on each truck.
