SUBJECT: NOTIFICATION OF THE ISSUANCE OF AND REQUEST FOR COMMENTS
ON THE DRAFT ENVIRONMENTAL IMPACT STATEMENT FOR THE
PROPOSED INTERNATIONAL ISOTOPES FLUORINE PRODUCTS FACILITY
IN LEA COUNTY, NEW MEXICO

Dear Mr. Delfin:

The U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC) staff is reviewing an application submitted by International Isotopes Fluorine Products, Inc. (IIFP) for a license to construct, operate, and decommission a proposed uranium processing facility. The facility is proposed to be located within a 640-acre section in Lea County near Hobbs, New Mexico, of which approximately 40 acres would be developed. The proposed facility, if licensed, would deconvert depleted uranium hexafluoride (DUF₆) into uranium oxide compounds for long-term disposal.

As part of the review of the application, the NRC has prepared a Draft Environmental Impact Statement (EIS) (NUREG-2113). The draft EIS includes an analysis of relevant environmental issues and documents the NRC staff's preliminary determination regarding the potential environmental impacts from the construction, operation, and decommissioning of the proposed facility. The NRC staff's preliminary determination is that potential impacts to ecological resources from construction, operation, and decommissioning of the proposed facility would be small.

The NRC staff is enclosing the draft EIS a compact disc (CD) for your review and comment. We are requesting your comments on the draft EIS and on our preliminary conclusions. The NRC staff will address your comments in the final EIS. Please provide any information or comments on the enclosed draft EIS that you consider appropriate during the comment period, which ends on February 27, 2012. Comments can be submitted either by mail to the Chief, Rules, Announcements, and Directives Branch, Division of Administrative Services, Office of Administration, Mailstop TWB-05-B01M, Washington, DC 20555-0001, or by e-mail to INIS_EIS.Resource@nrc.gov.

The NRC staff plans to hold a public meeting to discuss the contents of the draft EIS on Thursday, February 2, 2012 at the Lea County Event Center, 5101 Lovington Highway in Hobbs, New Mexico. The meeting will convene at 5:30 p.m. and will continue until 8:30 p.m. The meeting will be transcribed and will include the following agenda items: (1) a brief presentation of NRC's roles and responsibilities and the licensing process, (2) a presentation summarizing the contents of the draft EIS, and (3) an opportunity for interested government agencies, Tribal governments, organizations, and individuals to provide comments on the draft

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EIS. Additionally, the NRC staff will host informal discussions in an open house forum 1 hour before the start of the meeting, during which members of the public may meet and talk with NRC staff members.
