This refers to an investigation conducted by the NRC's Office of Investigations regarding activities at Acuren USA. The Office of Investigations initiated the investigation to determine whether a Non-Destructive Testing Rope Access Technician for Acuren USA Incorporated was subjected to discrimination by management for raising safety concerns.

Based on the evidence developed during the investigation, testimony, and document reviews, the alleged discrimination was determined to be not substantiated. The NRC plans no further action related to the discrimination aspect of this allegation and considers this investigation closed.
