Subject: 2011-10-10 Woodlan, Luminant Response to Comanche Peak Chapter 12 SE with Open Items and Letter

Ngola,

Luminant has reviewed the SE with Open Items. We found no material that should be withheld from public disclosure and no factual errors.

Below are some comments for your future consideration:

- Section 12.2.4, pg 12-19, the last sentence of the paragraph that is carried over from pg 12-18 states "RAI 3509, Question 12.02-2" when it should state "RAI 3509, Question 12.02-1".
- Section 12.2.4, pg 12-21, the 2nd sentence of the last paragraph of this section has the title of RAI 198 as "Questions Related to Standard License Conditions for 10 CFR Parts 10, 30, 40, and 70" when it should read "Questions Related to Standard License Conditions for 10 CFR Parts 30, 40, and 70".
- Section 12.3.4, pg 12-28, the first sentence on the page has in brackets "[number of zones]". These bracketed words should probably be replaced with a number.
- Section 12.4.4.1.9, pg 12-41, first line, revision 1 to RG 1.206 has not been issued.
- Section 12.4.4.1.9.2.1, pg 12-41, third sentence, Luminant has installed an ISFSI since FSAR revision 1 was published.
- Section 12.5.4, pg 12-62, the last sentence of the first full paragraph states that "the applicant added the following license condition for COL FSAR Section 11.5 in FSAR Table 13.4-201". In the supplement to RAI 3592 (see TXNB-10066 dated September 29, 2010) in response to feedback from the NRC, this license condition was regrouped with item 10 and FSAR section 12.5.
- Section 12.5.5, pg 12-64, the wording of License Condition 12-1 reads in part "excluding exempt qualities" when it should read "excluding exempt quantities".
- Section 12.5.5, pg 12-64, the means of creating the license conditions has changes since COLA revision 1. In COLA revision 2 Part 10 (and in the latest version of the model COL developed by the NRC staff), the operational program license conditions are rolled up into a single license condition which refers back to Table 13.4-201. For this SER, License Conditions 12-1, 12-2, 12-3 and 12-4 would become a single license condition which refers back to Table 13.4-201. The same is true for license condition 11.5 (reassigned as 12.5 – see above) on page 12-65.
