I have not received a response from you to my October 4 email stating that attempted to reach you by telephone to discuss your failure to respond to our September 2 letter. I requested that you contact me to let me know when you would be responding.

I attempted to reach you by telephone again today (10/12/11). I called your cell number, which referred me to leave a message at 787-721-7979. This number rang 7 times then disconnected the call. I called the International Cyclotron office number 787-753-5656; this number rang 14 times then disconnected.

We have not received a response from you to our letter dated September 2, 2011. A response was required within 30 days of the date of the letter. Note that the last paragraph of the letter stated "If we do not receive a reply from you within 30 calendar days from the date of this letter, we will consider appropriate enforcement actions, including civil penalties or Orders than can modify, suspend, or revoke your license."
