Gentlemen:

In accordance with the rulings of the atomic safety and licensing board at the conference in the captioned matter on November 11, 1970, I am transmitting herewith the documents listed below:

1. A document referred to on page 285 of the inspection reports consisting of pages 2 to 5. This document is privileged as proprietary in its entirety.
2. A document (Thornburg to O'Reilly, July 10, 1968) referred to at pages 222 and 280 of the inspection reports, consisting of 5 pages. Portions of this document are privileged as proprietary as indicated on the document and other portions are privileged as AEC internal matter as also indicated on the document. A deletion of AEC staff internal matter is also made on page 5 as approved by the board.
3. A report prepared by Parameter, Inc. for the AEC regulatory staff, (receipt dated October 24, 1966) and designated DCL-1 referred to at pages 151 and 260 of the inspection reports. This entire document is privileged as AEC internal matter, with the exceptions indicated in the record and in hand writing on the face of the document.
4. A report prepared by Parameter, Inc. for the AEC regulatory staff dated November 23, 1966 and designated DCL-4, which was referred to at pages 151 and 260 of the inspection reports. This entire document is privileged as AEC internal matter.
5. A report prepared by Parameter, Inc. for the AEC regulatory staff dated January 6, 1967 and designated DCL-5 which was referred to at pages 151 and 260 of the inspection reports. This entire document is privileged as AEC internal matter.

6. A document referred to at page 226 of the inspection reports (Thornburg to O'Reilly, June 25, 1968), consisting of two pages. As noted on the document, the first sentence of the final paragraph is privileged as AEC staff internal matter. As indicated the final sentence is deleted as an irrelevant reference to another facility.
