Dear Sir:

I want to register my strong opposition against beginning operation of the Nuclear Generating Plant at Monticello, Minnesota.

It is expected that the cancer rate in this area will rise due to the disposal of tritium into the water supply. The fact that scientists feel the radiation hazard is great enough to cause cancer in human beings should be reason enough not to begin operation of the plant.

To risk transporting and storing one million gallon radiative containers when one gallon can endanger millions of lives is irresponsible. Changing these tanks every 20 years is no mean matter either.

I feel you are overstepping your role as promoter of peaceful uses of atomic energy when you give license to nuclear plants before being absolutely sure they are not endangering the public.

Because I teach in the public schools I will not be able to attend the hearing on the Monticello Plant on April 28.
