Gentlemen:

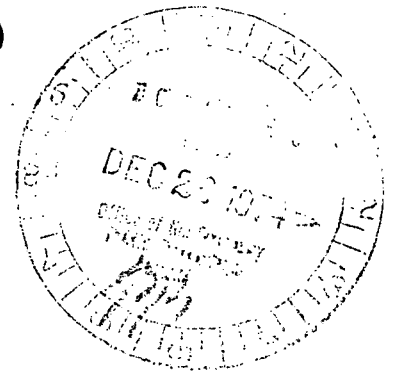
