Dear Ms. Yilma:

This letter transmits one CD and two (2) copies of the revised “privileged and confidential” maps depicting cultural resource sites overlain on the facilities and well fields of the proposed Dewey-Burdock Project. The well fields are shown as outlines that represent the monitor well rings that are approximately 400 feet beyond the edge of the well field. The map includes cultural sites in the following NHPA categories:

- Eligible
- Not Eligible
- Unevaluated

The map has been revised to show that two sites previously identified as unevaluated are actually not eligible. These sites are identified as 39FA1885 and 39CU3598. Also, this revised map includes the layout for both liquid waste disposal options so potential impacts can be assessed for both options. This map has been reviewed by Augustana College Archaeology Lab and the version being transmitted herewith is the correct and final map of cultural sites on the Dewey-Burdock project area.
