Summary of Discussion: Mr. Stroud confirmed that the permitted wastewater capacity of the Artesia Wastewater Treatment facility is 3.0 MGD (million gallons per day) and that average daily wastewater flow is 1.2 to 1.3 MGD. The city limits of Artesia bound the district lines. Mr. Stroud feels the 2009 Census Population estimate of 11,208 residents for Artesia is too low and that the Artesia population is 14,000 residents.
