I apologize for not responding last week. I'm currently attending the Low-Level Waste Forum meeting, but would like to provide via this email our response to the requested amendments to IW017/02 and XW010/02.

We recognize and concur with the response provided by Mike Garner, representing the Northwest Compact, in his email of September 16, 2011. As a member of that compact, Utah is supportive of that email.

However, I think it's important to restate, as we have noted in past responses regarding import/export application decisions by the NRC, that in previous matters involving the importation of low-level radioactive waste for processing and/or disposal in the US (and specifically at the Clive facility in Utah) have been opposed by the Governor of Utah and the majority of the citizens of Utah.
