Final Safety Analysis Report

Under separate cover 83 copies of the Final Safety Analysis Report for the Monticello Nuclear Generating Plant are being sent to you. The Final Safety Analysis Report is being filed in support of an application for an operating license for the Monticello Plant at power levels up to 1670 mw thermal.

As we have previously advised Mr. D. R. Muller of your staff, the Final Safety Analysis Report is being forwarded with the following sections missing:

1. Appendix B - Stack Release Limit Calculation for Monticello Site
2. Appendix D - Pre-operational and Start-up Tests

The missing information cited above will be completed, and submitted by amendment by November 8, 1968. A revised and updated application relating to the Final Safety Analysis Report and formally requesting an operating license for a power level of 1670 mw thermal will be submitted early in November. A proposed set of technical specifications will be submitted by December 9, 1968. A report on the reactor pressure vessel and containment vessel as built will be submitted shortly after February 1, 1969. *See reports section.*
