TERMINATION OF YOUR NRC RADIOACTIVE MATERIALS LICENSE

Dear Mr. Corwin:

In the letter dated April 5, 2011, you contacted the U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission and indicated that you wished change your mailing address to Tucson, Arizona and that your previous location at 1163 Maple Street, Farmington, Missouri was free of radioactive materials. As we discussed by telephone, we will issue you a new NRC license (under separate correspondence) for temporary jobsites only at your Arizona address and terminate your NRC Missouri license 24-32685-01. The NRC staff has reviewed the information you submitted and based on its review, has concluded that all licensable radioactive material has been removed from your facility in Farmington, Missouri. Based on these conclusions no further remediation or actions with respect to NRC regulated material is required. Your Missouri facility is suitable for unrestricted use and NRC license number 24-32685-01 is hereby terminated.
