Additional information relating to GL 88-01 was provided in your letter dated October 10, 1989 (LER 89-023).

The staff has evaluated the information provided in the above cited letters and determined that your response is acceptable. This issue is considered resolved for Monticello. A copy of our Safety Evaluation is forwarded for your information.

We note that the Monticello Technical Specification 4.6.D.1.a. requires that reactor coolant system leakage rates be recorded at least every four hours. The staff has determined that this frequency may be reduced to once every eight hours. At your option, you may submit an application to amend the Monticello Technical Specifications accordingly.
