Subject: Notification of Lincoln University's Intent to Respond

in Writing to Apparent Violations

Dear Ms. Bloomer:

This letter comes to notify you that Lincoln University intends to respond in writing to the five apparent violations being considered for escalated enforcement action by the Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC) listed below.

Failure to comply with the following:

- 1. Ensure that an NRC-approved individual fulfilled the responsibilities of the RSO after the RSO named on its NRC license retired;
- 2. Notify the NRC in writing when no principal activities have been conducted for a period of 24 months in accordance with Title 10 of the Code of Federal Regulations (10 CFR) 30.36(d);
- 3. Conduct a physical inventory to account for all sources and/or devices received and possessed under the NRC license;
- 4. Maintain records of receipt of radioactive materials; and
- 5. Comply with the requirements for acquiring, receiving, possessing, using, or transferring byproduct material in devices pursuant to a general license

We will send our response via mail prior to the November 13, 2011 deadline. Lincoln University is committed to working with the NRC to ensure that we comply with the conditions of our license and all applicable NRC regulations.
