

FIRST AMENDMENT TO  
MEMORANDUM OF AGREEMENT  
AMONG THE UNITED STATES NUCLEAR REGULATORY COMMISSION,  
THE IDAHO STATE HISTORIC PRESERVATION OFFICE,  
AND AREVA ENRICHMENT SERVICES LLC  
REGARDING THE PROPOSED EAGLE ROCK ENRICHMENT FACILITY PROJECT  
IN BONNEVILLE COUNTY, IDAHO  
(AGREEMENT)

WHEREAS the Memorandum of Agreement was executed in September of 2011;

WHEREAS other Federal agencies may be considering providing financial assistance to the Eagle Rock Enrichment Facility Project and wish to comply with Section 106 responsibilities for that assistance through this agreement;

NOW THEREFORE, in accordance with Stipulation E of the Agreement, the Nuclear Regulatory Commission, Idaho State Historic Preservation Office and AREVA Enrichment Services LLC agree to amend the Agreement as follows:

Insert the following Stipulation:

I. Coordination with Other Federal Reviews

In the event that AES applies for, or another Federal agency is considering, additional approvals or funding for the Eagle Rock Enrichment Facility, and the undertaking remains unchanged, such funding or approving agency may comply with Section 106 by agreeing in writing to the terms of this Agreement and notifying and consulting with SHPO and ACHP. Any necessary modifications will be considered in accordance with Stipulation E.
