I am responding to your letter, dated October 5, 2011 (ADAMS Accession No. ML11301A307), in which Honeywell International Inc. transmitted its documentation for its exemption request to modify its notification and reporting requirements under 10 CFR 40.60(b)(3) related to its on-site medical facility.

As part of the screening process, the NRC staff has completed the review of the information that Honeywell provided on October 21, 2011, and found the information acceptable for detailed review. During this review, we will notify you if any additional information, or clarification of existing information, is needed. The staff efforts associated with this review will be charged to Technical Assignment Control (TAC) number L32777. Please reference this TAC number in all correspondence related to this action.

Based on our preliminary review and projection of current review schedules, we anticipate completing our review of your request by April 2012. This date could change depending on the findings of our technical/administrative review, urgent assignments, or other factors. We will promptly communicate any significant changes to this schedule.
