Ladies and Gentlemen:

By letter dated September 2, 2011, Carolina Power & Light Company, doing business as Progress Energy Carolinas, Inc. (PEC), requested an amendment to Appendix A, Technical Specifications (TS), of Renewed Facility Operating License No. NPF-63 for the Shearon Harris Nuclear Power Plant, Unit 1 (HNP). The proposed amendment would revise the TS to extend TS 3.1.2.6, "Borated Water Sources – Operating," Action b allowed outage time for restoring an inoperable Refueling Water Storage Tank (RWST) to Operable status from one hour to seven days; and to extend the TS 3.5.4, "Refueling Water Storage Tank," Action for restoring an inoperable RWST to Operable status from one hour to seven days when performing purification in Modes 1-4.

HNP now understands that approval of the License Amendment Request would require an evaluation using a full-scope Probabilistic Risk Assessment (PRA), including a Seismic PRA meeting the Technical Characteristics and Attributes described in Regulatory Guide 1.200, "An Approach for Determining the Technical Adequacy of PRA Results for Risk-Informed Activities." As stated in the referenced License Amendment Request, the HNP seismic PRA model does not meet the ASME standard; therefore an alternate approach was provided which was judged by HNP to be adequate to support the requested change. Given that HNP cannot provide an evaluation developed using a qualified seismic PRA, HNP requests withdrawal of the referenced License Amendment Request.

In accordance with 10 CFR 50.91(b), HNP is providing the state of North Carolina with a copy of this letter.
