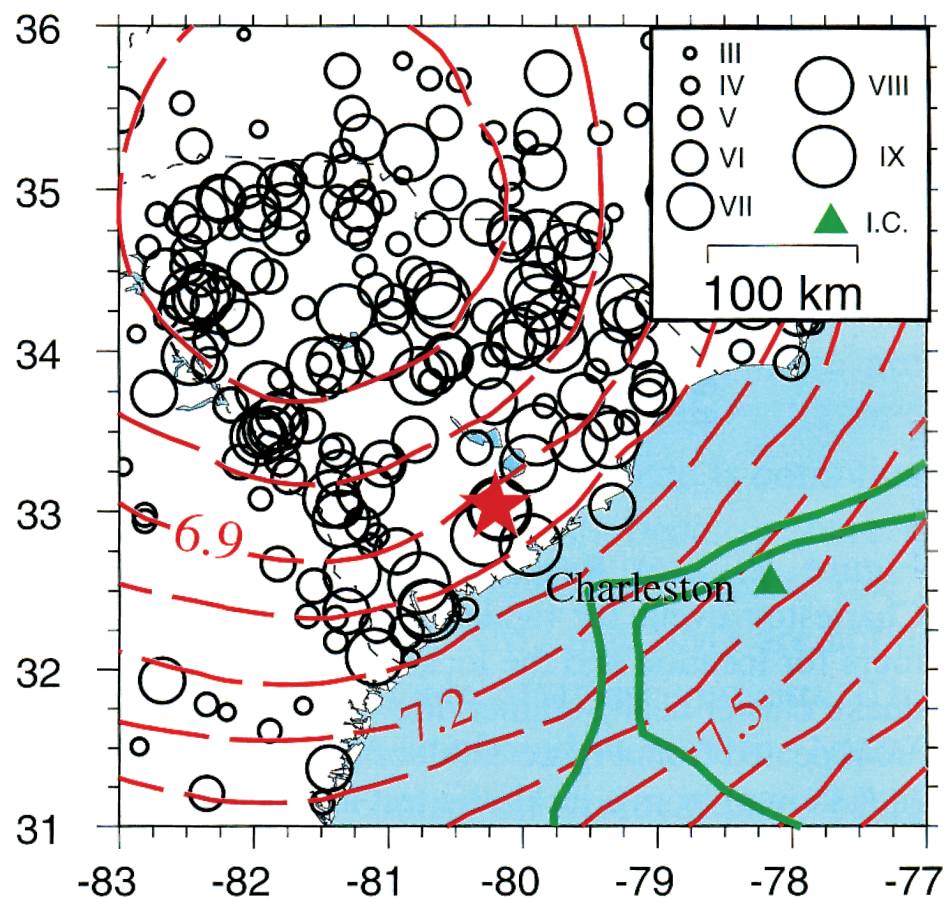

Figure shows the offshore location of estimated intensity center (green triangle) for the September 1, 1886, Charleston, South Carolina, earthquake. Red star is the location of a cluster of epicenters of recent small earthquakes near Summerville-Middleton Place and is the preferred epicenter. Black circles are sites with MMI assignments. The contours of intensity magnitude (dashed red lines) are the best estimates of M from the MMI assignments for assumed epicenters on that contour.
