In early June 2011, John Budzynski, James Gilmer, and Eugene Eagle submitted suggestions via the suggestion process related to improvements to BWR/PWR plants in respect to the Fukushima Dai-Ichi accident. We received an acknowledgement from Kreslyon Fleming, Outreach and Recruitment Branch, on June 10, 2011 which stated:
