As you are aware, President Clinton issued a Memorandam on June 5, 1997, encouraging the use of Project I shor Agreements by all departments and agencies with regard to the award of contracts for the construction of a facility to be owned by a Federal department or agency. The President's Memorandam applies to projects which will cost more than \$5 million. Further, the Memorandam allows the use of Project Labor Agreements in leasehold arrangements and other federally funded projects.
