


Yes we did and I closed the loop with Brian. I'll find the email I sent and forward to you. Thought I had you copied as well.

Good talking to you this morning. The SOARCA Communication Plan, Revision 4, issued January 2010, is attached (ML100280027). The memo that transmitted the plan to the Commission is attached as well (ML100271726). We are currently revising the SOARCA schedule. We plan to meet with the SOARCA Steering Committee (Jim Lyons, Jack Grobe, Bill Dean, Gary Holahan and Cyndi Pederson) by next week to obtain approval for the revised schedule. The Comm. Plan will then be revised to reflect the new schedule and provided to the Commission. Just to let you know that a revision (rev. 5) to what you are getting is now in the works.

Regarding our interactions with the regions, we have typically dealt with the SRAs. Region I SRAs have been more involved than the others. They even accompanied us to Peach Bottom during site visits.

Cyndi Pederson has always emphasized that we ensure the regions are kept updated. Our plan involves multiple regional briefings, including going to the regions, before the draft SOARCA documents are provided to the Commission and before they are made available for public review and comment.

By the way, Rich Guzman is the SOARCA team's NRR link.
