I discussed with Ms. Barlow, that I had made a mistake and that she could apply for an exemption of Part 20. She discussed that she wanted to dispose of the lights by transferring to a recycling facility. This facility would vent the krypton to atmosphere like it was an effluent and then recycle the mercury in the light. I discussed that they could request for a 10 CFR 20.2001 exemption to transfer it to a non-licensee recycler which would process the krypton like an air effluent, similar to allowed by part 20 and but the recycler would retain the mercury which would be better for the public. She said that she would review and submit.
