1.	11/1/11	The data was provided by the NRC's Nuclear Material Events Database (NMED) on November 1, 2011. The data consists of 12 records of leaking calibration/marker sources reported to the NRC per 10 CFR 35.67(e) during the last 10 years (10/31/2001 - 11/01/2011). The sources contain either Co-57, Cs-137, or Ba-133. The NMED does not consistently contain information regarding whether these sources are "epoxy sealed", so some of the events may not strictly meet the requested criteria (but were provided for completeness).
