Due to a dwindling volunteer staff and a change of direction in our collection from environmental subjects to alternative life styles, we would like to divest ourselves of our status as a local public repository.

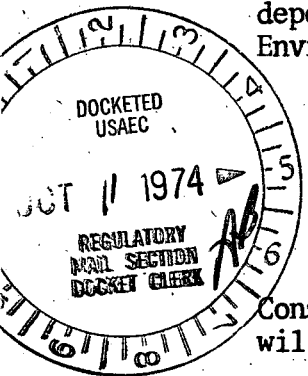
The Environmental Library was made a repository for materials concerning Northern States Power Company's Monticello Plant in April, 1970. Later, we received the correspondence and reports concerning the Prairie Island Nuclear Plant from the Red Wing Public Library at the request of the Minnesota Pollution Control Agency.

We would like permission to transfer the public documents depository materials we hold to the Environmental Conservation Library at the Minneapolis Public Library, which is the environmental library for the State of Minnesota. We would also like to request that any public document depository materials which would be sent to us in the future be sent to the Environmental Conservation Library (ECOL). ECOL's address is:
