To Whom It May Concern::

1. Please delete Eric D. Johnson, M.D. as an authorized user effective immediately.
2. During our recent license renewal we were asked to confirm that patients administered radioactive materials permitted by 10 CFR 35.300 and 10 CFR 35.400 will be releasable pursuant to 10 CFR 35.75. We confirmed that we do not perform in-patient therapies and that all patients are releasable pursuant to 10 CFR 35.75. When we received our license renewal, we discovered that we were now limited to uses of I-131 in quantities under 33 mCi. We did not indicate nor intend to limit our uses of I-131 to quantities under 33 mCi. We only intended to indicate that we do not use I-131 on patients who cannot be released pursuant to 10 CFR 35.75. Clearly, there was a miscommunication and we are requesting that the our license be amended to reflect that we have full use of I-131 with the proviso that uses of I-131 be limited to patients who can be released pursuant to 10 CFR 35.75.
